Infill Task Force Meeting

Community Meeting June 20th 6:30 at West End Building – purpose to inform the public - will have some displays to get feedback on different ideas. R6 issues, side yard set back, overlay zones among other issues will be highlighted.

Community Center Update

Committee met for a year – final meeting last Wednesday. Completed proposal estimates total cost at \$77 million (includes land, not library) will be presented to city council and put before vote

Alley Clean-Up Results/next steps

43 thousand pounds over two days – Allied went above and beyond what was alley trash – phase one is complete. Lisa testified at City Council to give Allied credit. Next steps include enforcements of encroachments, such as vegetation growing in alley. Homeowners are responsible for any plant material

General Announcements

Stop signs – phase one completed. Two more phases to go. Residents will receive a letter before each phase. Next phase, new signs, then changing stop signs and then removal. Changing the pattern of the signs so that every other intersection will have a stop sign. Completion expected by end of summer. Will then analyze the effectiveness.
